Water Quality Monitoring: RMB is compiling the invoicing for the lakes program. No price changes are expected from what we originally planned last spring. HC COLA has the zebra mussel and spiny waterflea taxonomy invoices which reflected a slight inflation increase over spring planning. E-Team approved covering difference for 2022. In 2023, we will lock in pricing for taxonomy analysis, in addition to the RMB Lakes Program pricing. The HC SWCD is discussing the local water plan this autumn which has covered \$1300 annually in the past to help offset some of the lakes program sampling fees.

HC COLA **Shoreland Advisors** shared in an Oct hybrid mtg, the multiple site visits on Belle Taine, Spider & Fish Hook; received info from HC SWCD on shoreland restoration concepts to utilize in future and also to provide feedback on.

Our Hubbard County **Loon Liaison** hybrid update is in planning stages for this autumn. Don't forget that your LoonWatcher Surveys are due to the DNR by 12/15/2022.
