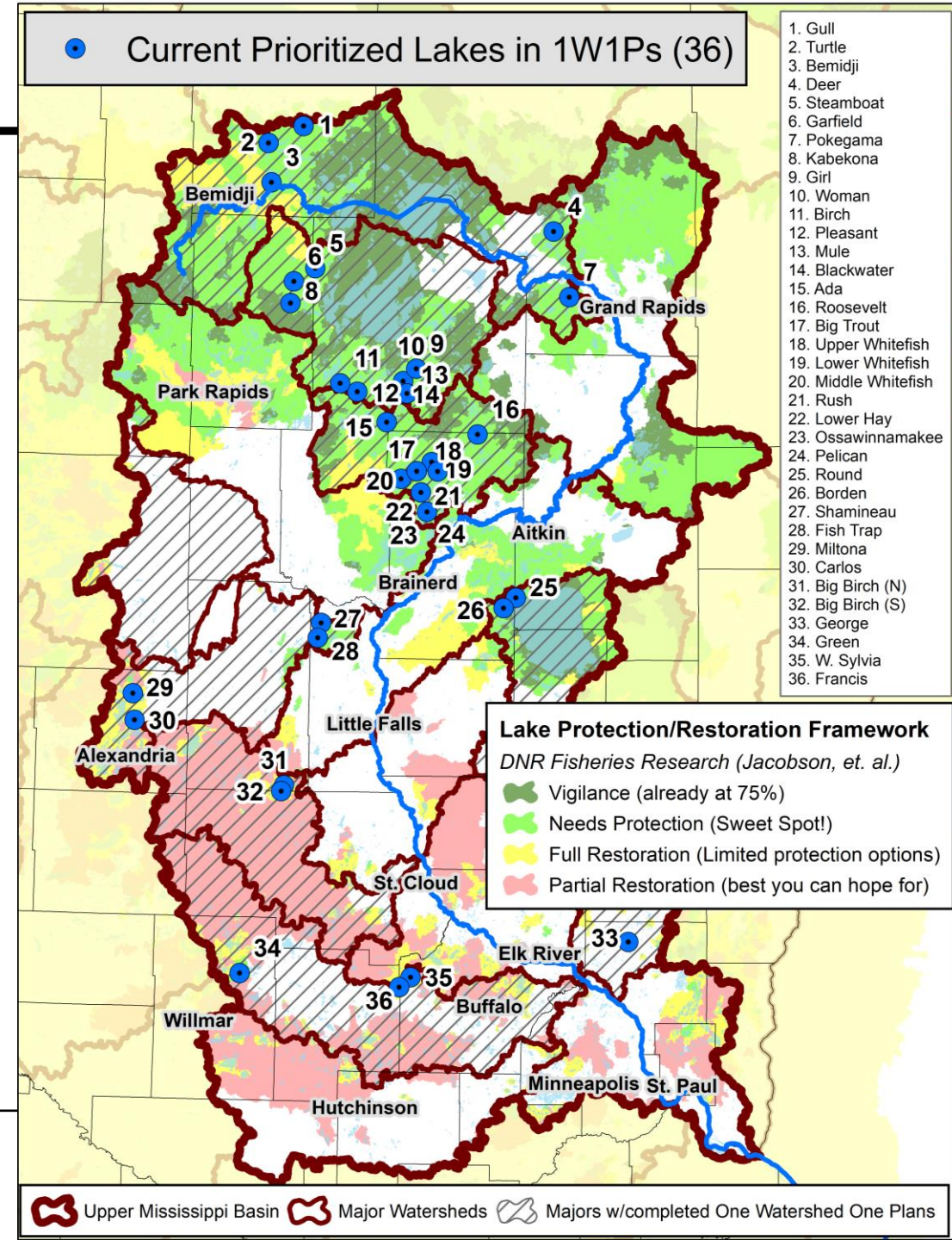
ABOUT THIS GRANT

- Start – 2024 End – May 2028
- Target and protect the water quality of the 26 best fishing lakes in the Upper Mississippi River Basin (UMRB).
- Create, or update, Lake plans for the 26 lakes.
- Hold landowner workshops to educate lakeshed landowners.
- Create a Small Acre Stewardship Plan (SASP) for the 26 lakeshed landowners.
- Enroll landowners into SFIA for lakeshed protection.

**Most all of these will become available for the whole County in the near future and will expand to other priority lakes if funding lasts*

HOW WILL WE DO THIS?

- Work with partners to do outreach and hold educational workshops.
- Create public awareness material for landowners.
- Continue to gather PL data to add more lakes (*10 have been added since we got the grant*).
- Work with Lake Associations to get accurate and localized lake plans updated/complete.
- Implement forestry Best Management Practices (BMP's) on SASP's.
- Create success stories to use for future funding opportunities.





NEXT STEPS

- We will start with 26 lakes, then do the next 10 if funding is available.
 - Keep Lake Associations updated on future funding.
 - Have this program offered to any Lake Association in Hubbard County after templates are complete.
 - Attend future Lake Association meetings about other Forestry programs and grants.
